

CURRENT CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAW

ARTICLE V: EXECUTIVE BOARD

SECTION 1 – MEMBERSHIP

- A. The executive board shall consist of an awards chairperson, historian, membership chairperson, member services chairperson, journal editor, and public relations chairperson. These members are appointed by the officers for one (1) year terms. The hall of fame chairperson is appointed by the officers for a two (2) year term. The NIAAA liaison, retired members liaison, IADA business manager, leadership training coordinator, and mentoring coordinator are appointed by the officers for three (3) year terms. The position of Strategic Plan Coordinator to be appointed to the Executive Board as needed. The board also includes a division liaison from each legislative division elected annually at the conference and the five elected officers. If any appointed position or division liaison position is vacated the officers shall appoint a replacement to complete the term (ARTICLE IV). Appointed positions may be reappointed. Division liaisons may be re-elected. If a legislative division is not represented on the executive board by more than the division liaison, an at-large member for that division shall be appointed by the officers for a one year term. At-large members may be reappointed as per this section.
- B. Elections shall be conducted for division liaisons by the athletic administrators of various divisions at the annual spring IADA state conference according to the following schedule:
- a. In 1992 and each third year thereafter: divisions 3, 5, and 6
 - b. In 1993 and each third year thereafter: divisions 1 and 4
 - c. In 1994 and each third year thereafter: divisions 2 and 7

ARTICLE V: EXECUTIVE BOARD

SECTION 1 – MEMBERSHIP

- A. The executive board shall consist of awards chairperson, historian, membership chairperson, journal editor, public relations chairperson, hall of fame chairperson, NIAAA liaison, retired members liaison, business manager, leadership training coordinator, and mentoring coordinator. These members will serve three (3) year terms and will be nominated by the membership at the district/sectional meetings. The position of Strategic Plan Coordinator will be appointed to the executive board as needed. The board also includes division liaisons from each legislative division. If any executive board position or division liaison position is vacated the officers shall appoint a replacement to complete the term (ARTICE IV: OFFICERS Section 7 – Unexpired Terms of Officers.) Appointed positions and division liaisons may be re-elected. If a legislative position is not represented on the executive board by more then the division liaison, and at-large member for that division shall be appointed by the officers for a one (1) term year. At-large members may be re-appointed each year.
- B. Elections shall be conducted for executive board and division liaison positions at the annual spring IADA State Conference according to the following schedule:
- a. In 2006 and each third year thereafter divisions 2 and 7
 - b. In 2007 and each third year thereafter divisions 3, 5, and 6
Secretary, awards chairperson, historian, membership chair, and business manager.
 - c. In 2008 and each third year thereafter divisions 1 and 4
Treasurer, hall of fame chair, NIAA chair, leadership training coordinator, and mentoring coordinator.
 - d. In 2009 and each third year thereafter, journal chair, public relations chair, retired members liaison.
